

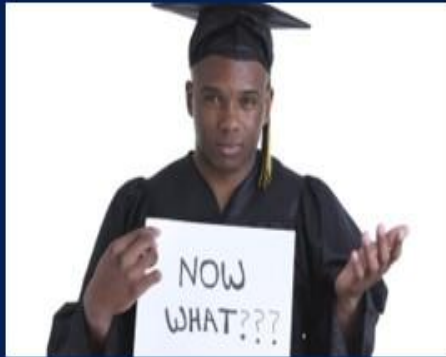

Four-year College or University

- These schools offer bachelor's degrees, which are usually completed in four years of full-time study, and some schools offer graduate degrees as well.

WHERE DO I BEGIN?

Technical College

- Provides specialized training in a specific career field, trade, or profession, including computer technology, business administration, culinary arts, electronics, medical assisting, legal assisting, automotive technology, and cosmetology.
- Programs at technical colleges can take anywhere from less than two years and typically award a certificate, diploma, or associate's degree.

Two-Year College

- An educational institution offering a two year degree called an Associate's degree that is generally the equivalent of the first two years of a four-year undergraduate degree.

EXAMPLES OF DIFFERENT TYPES OF SCHOOLS

- Four Year Colleges:
 - University of Georgia
 - Georgia Tech
- Two Year Colleges:
 - Sometimes referred to as Community Colleges since they do not have on campus housing
 - Georgia Highlands College (offers 10 Bachelor's degrees as well)
- Technical Colleges:
 - Chattahoochee Technical College
 - West Georgia Technical College



NAVIANCE

BY HOBSONS

- **Naviance** is a college and career platform purchased by CCSD to assist students with post secondary planning.
 - You can access Naviance by clicking Naviance under the “Find it Fast” menu at the top of any CCSD webpage. Students login using their CCSD login and password. You cannot access Naviance via Google.
- Naviance syncs with Common App, so any college added to Common App will automatically be listed in the student’s Naviance account under Colleges I’m Applying To.
- Naviance is a great place to research colleges, careers, and scholarships.

HOPE GRANT &

ZELL MILLER GRANT

HOPE Grant- (a separate program from the HOPE Scholarship) is available to Georgia residents who are working towards a certificate or diploma (continuing education programs are not eligible) at an eligible college or university in Georgia.

Zell Miller Grant- (Academic Eligibility)

- Full-time enrollment is not required and students are not required to graduate from high school with a specific GPA, however, a minimum 3.5 postsecondary Calculated HOPE GPA, at the end of each term, is required in order to maintain eligibility. The first term of enrollment will be paid retroactively if the student has the required 3.5 postsecondary calculated HOPE GPA at the end of the term.

HOPE CAREER GRANT



The HOPE Career Grant is available to HOPE Grant-qualified students who enroll in select majors specifically aligned with industries in which there are more jobs available in Georgia than there are skilled workers to fill them. These industries have been identified as strategically important to the state's economic growth.

This free program allows students to earn a certificate or diploma at one of Georgia Technical Colleges for free.

**Examples of some of the programs: *Welding *Carpentry
*Certified Nursing Assistant *Medical Assistant &
*Drafting Technology.**

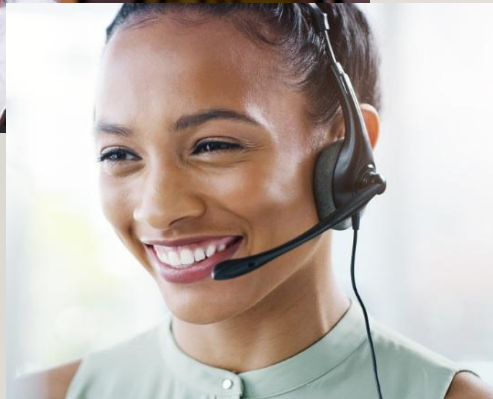

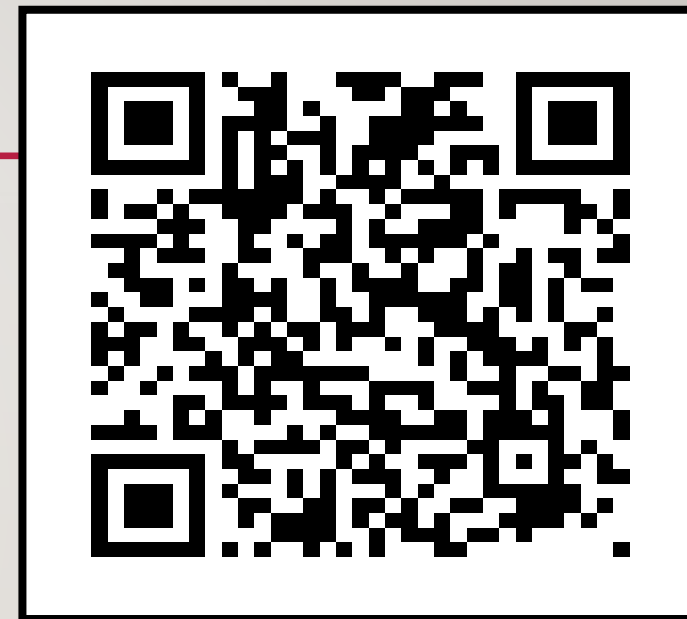
