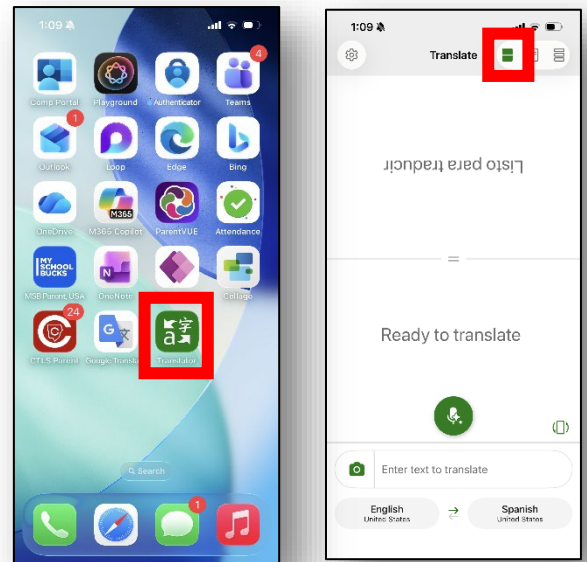


Using the Microsoft Translator App

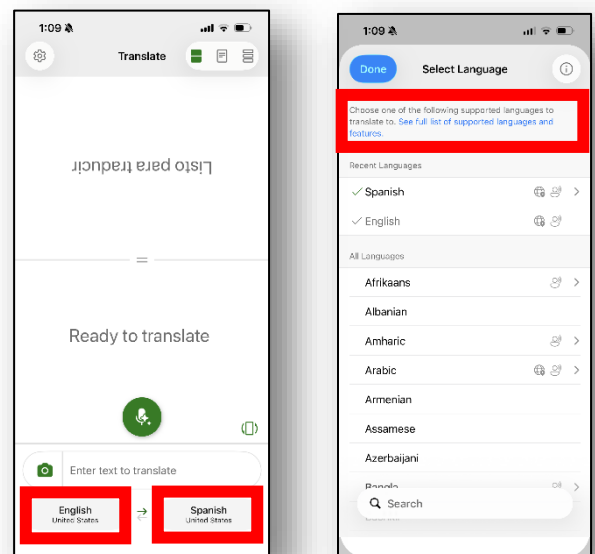
These directions explain how to use the Microsoft Translator app.

Navigating the Translator App

1. Open the **Microsoft Translator app** and tap the **Conversation icon**.



2. Select the two **languages** needed at the bottom of the screen. When on the Select Language page, click on '**See full list of supported languages and features**' to see which features are available for each language.
Note: Some languages are only supported in text and will not read aloud.



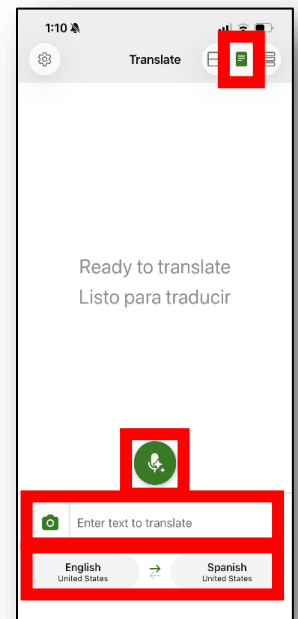
3. Type or dictate what you would like to have translated. Allow the parent or other party to read the translation or click the **play button** to have it read to them.

Note: Not all languages are available to play.



4. On the individual translate feature, select the two **languages** needed at the bottom. Once languages have been chosen, you can type, dictate, or take a picture of the text you want to translate.

Note: Features are limited for some languages.



5. Select the **History icon** to see a record of past translations. Translations can also be shared with others.
