The teacher will implement it by providing each student with appropriate reading passages, key current vocabulary, a review of WICOR Strategies, and feedback on writing during bi-weekly Tuesday DEN Time.  What artifacts will be used to show implementation? Bi-weekly administrative walk-through forms, CCC unit plans, and student writing samples.  What evidence will be used to monitor the outcome?  Common Lit diagnostic assessment, Two Common Lit cold-read assessments during the semester	
As measured through bi-weekly walk-throughs during weekly DEN (Dedicated to Engaging students' Needs) Intervention time, American Literature students will utilize the WICOR (an AVID program strategy using Writing, Inquiry, Collaboration, Organization, and Reading) reading and writing strategies while reading passages and developing written responses using current vocabulary.	2024	Performance Target: 80% of bi-weekly walk-throughs will show students utilizing the writing and reading components of the WICOR strategies while incorporating current content vocabulary.  Implementation (include person responsible):  During October professional learning (PL), Am Lit teachers will receive training/review of WICOR strategies as well as expectations on how to use current vocabulary during bi-weekly DEN Time  Students will complete writing and reading work while incorporating current content vocabulary during DEN Time  Artifacts: Student writing samples as well as the administrative walk-through forms, AVID newsletter.  Progress Monitoring: Bi-weekly administrative walk-throughs will also be monitored to ensure implementation and participation

It will be implemented by the teacher presenting constructed response problems and error analysis to each student during each Tuesday's DEN Time.  What artifacts will be used to show implementation? Administrative Walk-through forms completed each week.  What evidence will be used to monitor the outcome? Student positive progression on unit assessments.	
Every Tuesday during DEN Intervention, measured by bi-weekly walk-throughs, the Foundations of Algebra and Algebra I students will complete one or more constructed-response problems and error analyses.
